What Amazonian Archaeology Can Tell Us About the Future of the Tropics

This presentation will show how traditional Amazonian populations have transformed their natural settings and created cultural landscapes over the millennia. Given that such populations and landscapes have never been as threatened as they are today, it will be argued that efforts to preserve the Amazon must also include initiatives to protect the livelihoods of its traditional populations.
